At INP, we believe in building strong relationships with our investors. Your support is crucial in helping us achieve our mission of promoting economic growth and development in the Inland Northwest region.



With a variety of speakers from around our region sharing examples and visions of what attainable housing looks like within northern Idaho and eastern Washington.

We had approximately 75 attendees and our survey results rated it a 4.73 out of 5.
